
ADDITIONAL NOTES

After playing your *Spiccato* for some time, do not hesitate to check the adjustment setting. The internal mechanism is very precise and does not vary, nevertheless it is possible that after the first hours of vibration, the bow will loose some of its camber. This is normal. After the second adjustment the bow will stabilize permanently.

The Spiccato is a bow that does not need to be tighty haired, unless played without tightening the adjuster.



Easy way to find "point zero" (setting 0):

- 1) remove the frog from the stick
- 2) loosen the mechanism (7 or 8 turns)
- tighten stick lightly in a clamp, resting the head lightly on workbench.
- 4) insert the key into button cavity
- 5) turn until head raises from table

"Point zero" is the position just as the head begins to rise.

NOTE: The original setting (when purchased) is at 1.5 turns.

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Presentation

Benoît ROLLAND, master archetier (bow maker) and violinist, conceived and prepared the *Spiccato* bow in collaboration with reknowned modern technicians: these qualities place it on the level of the finest traditional bows. The carbon-fiber based stick remains unchanged no matter where you play, indoors and out (the only variable, like any other bow, is the hair which changes playability due to heat and humidity).

This bow is equipped with an invisible adjusting system that is simple to use, internationally patented, and offers the possibility of changing the flexibility of the stick according to personal taste. Thus, your Spiccato will adjust to your playing, rendering the exact type of bow that suits you.

In addition to the unique adjusting system, *Spiccato* is surprisingly comfortable to play. Smoothness, agility, weight and balance, powerful sound, sensitivity: all these are carefully planned to offer the greatest playing pleasure.

The elegant lines and the refined brilliance of the stick complimented by its playing qualities make your *Spiccato* one of the finer bows that you can play under any circumstance.

INSTRUCTION GUIDE

Instruction for flexibility adjustment

The adjuster is regulated with the special key, through the button cavity of the bow. (see drawing)

- 1) remove the frog from the stick, holding it so as not to touch the hair with your fingers, and not tangle it
- 2) hold the stick and the frog in left hand
- 3) with your right hand take the special key and insert it into the button cavity till it touches the interior screw
- 4) by turning the key clockwise the stick bends, increasing sensitivity. By turning counter clockwise, the sensitivity is reduced...


WARNING!

- ♦ You may change the flexibility within 3 complete turns.
- Never use anything but the special key to adjust flexibility.
- Never exceed 3 turns when adjusting: this risks damaging the adjuster and the bow will become difficult to control.

Suggestions for adjusting

The adjustment system is sensitive, and you will feel a difference in your bow from the first turn.

- first find setting "0". At the time of purchase the bow is at setting "1.5", thus, turn the key counter-clockwise 1.5 turns to find setting "0". Then play the bow for a few hours
- when you are familiar with your Spiccato at this setting, turn the adjuster 1 complete turn clockwise. (this is setting "1")
- 3) play for a few hours
- 4) turn another complete turn.(this is setting "2")
- 5) repeat these steps through 3rd turn.



IMPORTANT: your Spiccato is originally set at 1.5 turns when purchased.

When you have established the 3 multiple settings, you can find the setting that is best for you.

These steps are important because their result will allow you the greatest playing pleasure. You may also adjust your *Spiccato* whenever you choose, according to need.

NOTE: It is not necessary to loosen the adjuster after each use. However, it is recommended to reduce the setting when not used for long periods of time.

Other suggestions:

Spiccato was created with the greatest care. It will render complete satisfaction if cared for like all traditional bows. Even though the stick is not subject to deformities, the following suggestions are recommended:

- 1) loosen the hair after each use
- do not expose the bow to excessive heat (for example the rear window of a car in direct sunlight).
- 3) avoid sudden shocks (tapping the music stand to aplaud the conductor, etc...)
- 4) do not overtighten the adjuster

For your pleasure and to keep it in excellent condition :

 $\, \Diamond \,$ clean the stick and the frog regularly with a soft cloth touched lightly in clear polish (avoid contact with the hair).

IMPORTANT: avoid use of any solvent (acetone, trichloriteline), that could harm the stick.
